Guide to Seesaw



STEP 1 Go to the Seesaw website or download the Seesaw class APP.

✓ **Laptops + Computers:** Visit app.seesaw.me

✓ **Tablets + Mobile Devices:** Download or update the Seesaw Class app in your device's app store.

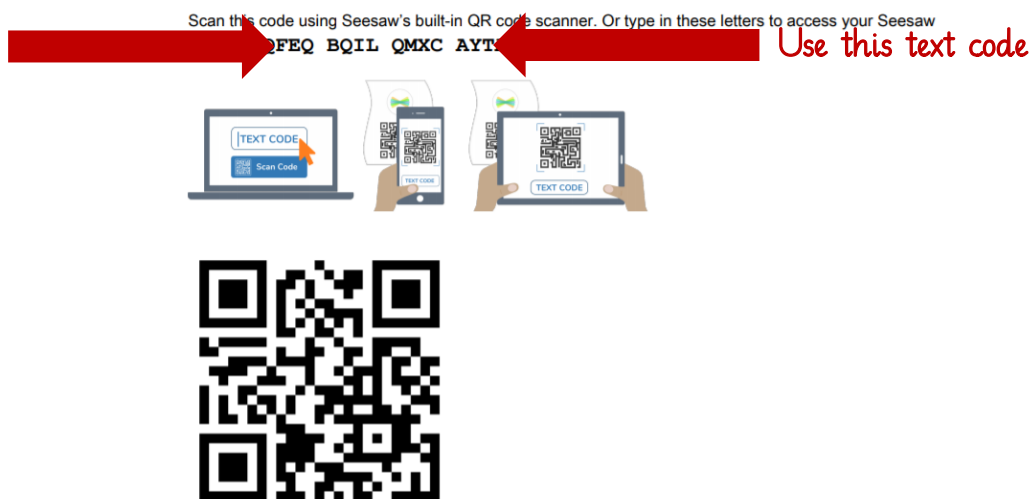


STEP 2 Log into Seesaw

- ✓ Click I am a student
- ✓ Log in using the Home Learning Code or QR Code (this is stuck inside your child's homework book).



Your child's log in details look like this and are stuck inside their homework books.



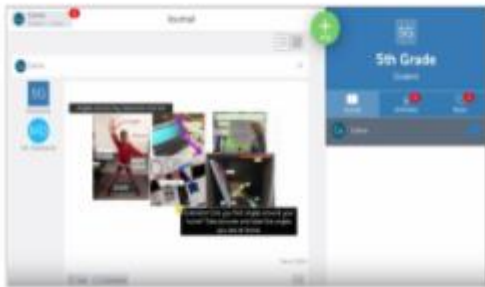
Trouble Logging in?

- ✓ Make sure you are using the Seesaw CLASS APP and not Seesaw or Seesaw family.
- ✓ Make sure you have clicked I'm a student.
- ✓ Make sure the text code (12-digits on log in sheet) has been text code has been typed in accurately.
- ✓ Your text code has expired. Email your class teacher for a new code.
- ✓ Check if the APP needs an update.

Siblings

When multiple children are using the same device, each child should log out of their account when they have finished. We recommend using QR codes to log in quickly for siblings.
