I hope you had a lovely summer and are ready for a new year at school. This term the children will be taking a practical approach to learning to help with a smooth transition from Reception to Year 1.


### This half term our topic is **Room on the Broom.**

#### English:

In English we are going to be learning how to recount and writing sentences linked to our story using capital letters and full stops.

#### Maths:

In maths we are looking at place value. We are learning how to use inequality signs and how to compare numbers and amounts.



#### Science:

We are going to learn about Autumn and every day materials. We will be going for a walk around West Park to look at different attributes associated with Autumn and we will going on a material hunt around our school!

20 minutes of reading per day is recommended for children to do at home. An example would be reading a bedtime story every night! Please write the names of the books your children have been reading in their reading diaries.

Please encourage your children to practice their handwriting at home. The West Park Mnemonics which we follow are inside their homework books.

Please ask your children to practice their 121 addition facts which are inside their homework books. They need to learn to answer all the questions in the quickest time they can. Any children who get all their questions write in our tests at school will receive a certificate in our celebration assemblies! We will test the children one a week.
