

<p>Mammals</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 4 legs and ears that stick out Have hair or fur Warm blooded Have lungs and need air to breathe Nurse their babies with milk Give birth to live young 	<p>Reptiles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cold blooded 4 legs or no legs Usually lay eggs but sometimes have live young Dry, scaly skin (no fur or hair) Breathe with lungs Ear holes instead of ears 	<p>Amphibians</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cold blooded Live in land and water Lays many eggs Without fur 4 legs or sometimes none Breathe with lungs and gills Moist smooth skin (no hair or fur) 	<p>Fish</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cold blooded Lives in water Lays many eggs Has scales and fins (not hair or fur) Breathe underwater using gills not lungs 	<p>Birds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Has feathers and wings Has 2 legs Lays eggs Warm blooded Ear holes instead of ears
