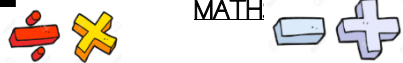


Year 6

MATH

This term we will be focussing on;

- **Calculations**
- **Statistics**
- **Geometry**

poems and a formal text that has been written in collaboration with Y7 teachers to help prepare the children for their transition to secondary school.

Children will be learning about Jewish, Hindu and Islamic prayer



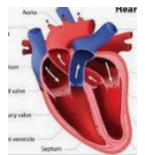
PE

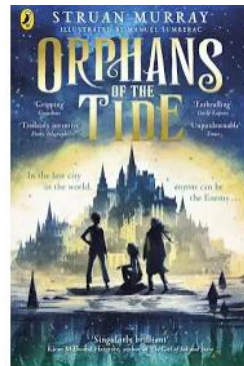
Reading in Y6

enjoying this book with all of its twists and turns and fantastic vocabulary. Ask them to tell you about it!

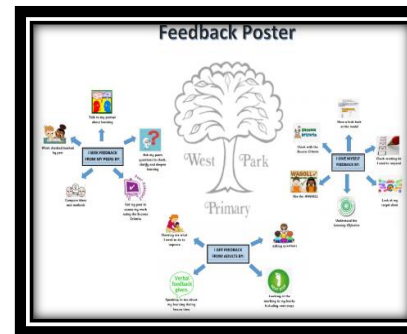
Y6 currently have 3 book boxes on loan from the Education library service as well as weekly
