## Welcome back!

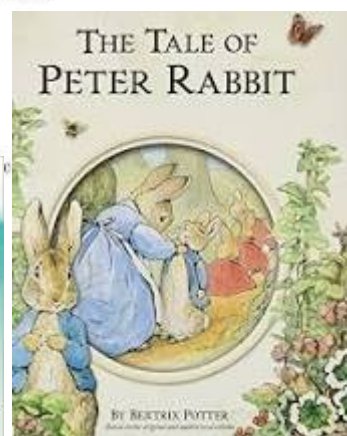
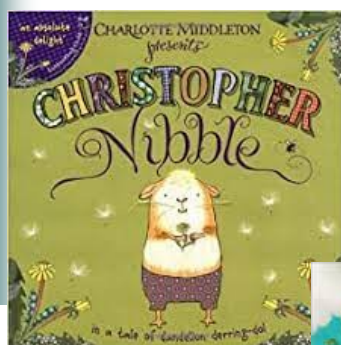
