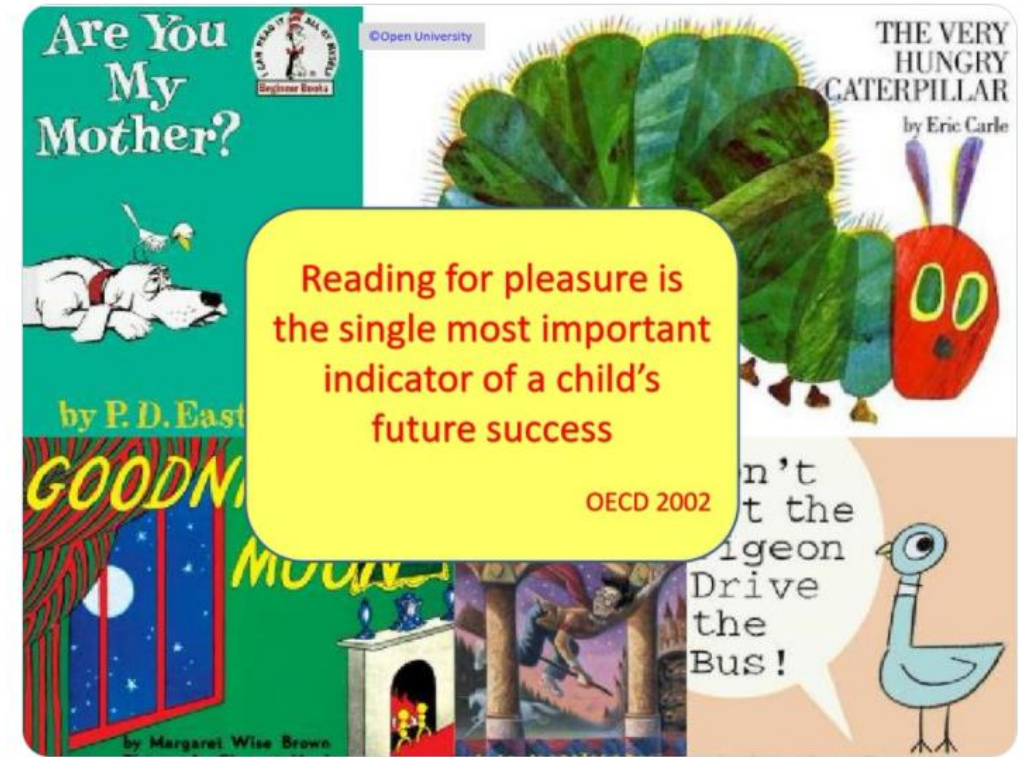
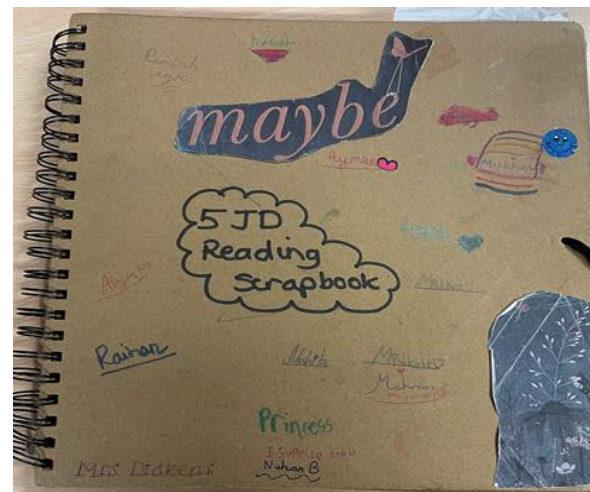


Tom's Midnight Garden
