Year 1

Handa's Surprise (Autumn 2)

Artwork linked to 'Handa's Surprise.'
Printing with fruit, Observational drawings of halved fruit. Fruit sculptures with plasticene.
Explore lines and patterns of animal skins/Kenyan tribal prints including artists such as Bisa Butler.



Dragons (Spring 2)

Inspired by 'Zog.' Use plasticene to make Zog

Paint pictures of Zog using red and yellow to make orange. How to draw a simple dragon tutorial.

Explore colour mixing to make green and purple to paint dragons. Use end of brush to draw scales in the paint.

Rubbings of different surfaces to make different scales. Study Chinese dragons.







Waves (Summer 2)

Hokusai artist study.

Focus on the painting 'The Great Wave.'

Collaborative wave by drawing round hands and use a range of white and blue collage materials. Make own sea collage by ripping and arranging blue collage materials.

Listen and respond to wave sounds using white wax and a blue wash.

Make sea sculptures by curling white and blue paper.
