


# Welcome to Year 6

To help you have a better idea of what your child is doing at school, these are some of the topics we will be covering.



## MATHS

This term we will be focussing on,

- Quick recall of number facts.
- Ratio and proportion
- Geometry
- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Statistics.

## ENGLISH

This term we will be reading and writing about 'The Leopard' by Ruskin Bond. Children will be writing:

Children will be learning all about mountains. They will be thinking about the following questions;
