


English

History

In History, we will explore life in Victorian Britain.

In Art, we will learn about the Victorian artist William Morris. We will be creating illuminated letters and print designs in the style of William Morris.




Computing

French

Children will have French every Tuesday with Mrs Farrell. This term the theme is *Moi et mon école*

Music

Children will have Music every Tuesday with Mrs Farrell. This term the theme is *Exploring Rhythm and Pulse*
Cyclic Patterns

Maths

In Maths, we will focus on *Number, Addition and Subtraction*.

Children will focus on numbers to a million and reading numbers up to 3 decimal places understanding tenths, hundredths and thousandths.

Science

In our Science topic 'Properties and Changing Materials'. We will:

- Compare and group everyday materials based on their properties.
- Explore solids, liquids and gases.
- Explore reversible and irreversible changes

PSHE

We will be discussing 'Peer Pressure'. We will identify ways to keep ourselves and others safe and recognising ways to manage peer pressure. We will also explore the possible outcomes when we take risks.

PE

Children will need their PE kit in school everyday.

PE kit includes:

Plain white t-shirt

Plain black joggers, shorts or leggings

Waterproof trainers

Optional: Black jumper or hoodie for outdoor PE.



Children will be outside, in all weather, for PE.

Mr Pitt will take PE lessons on a Tuesday (this will be outdoor PE). This term children will be taking part in High 5 Netball.


Math Revision

Feedback Poster




Who gives me feedback?
