ming on Mondays this half term

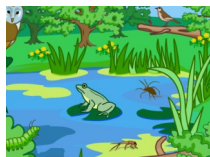

MATHS

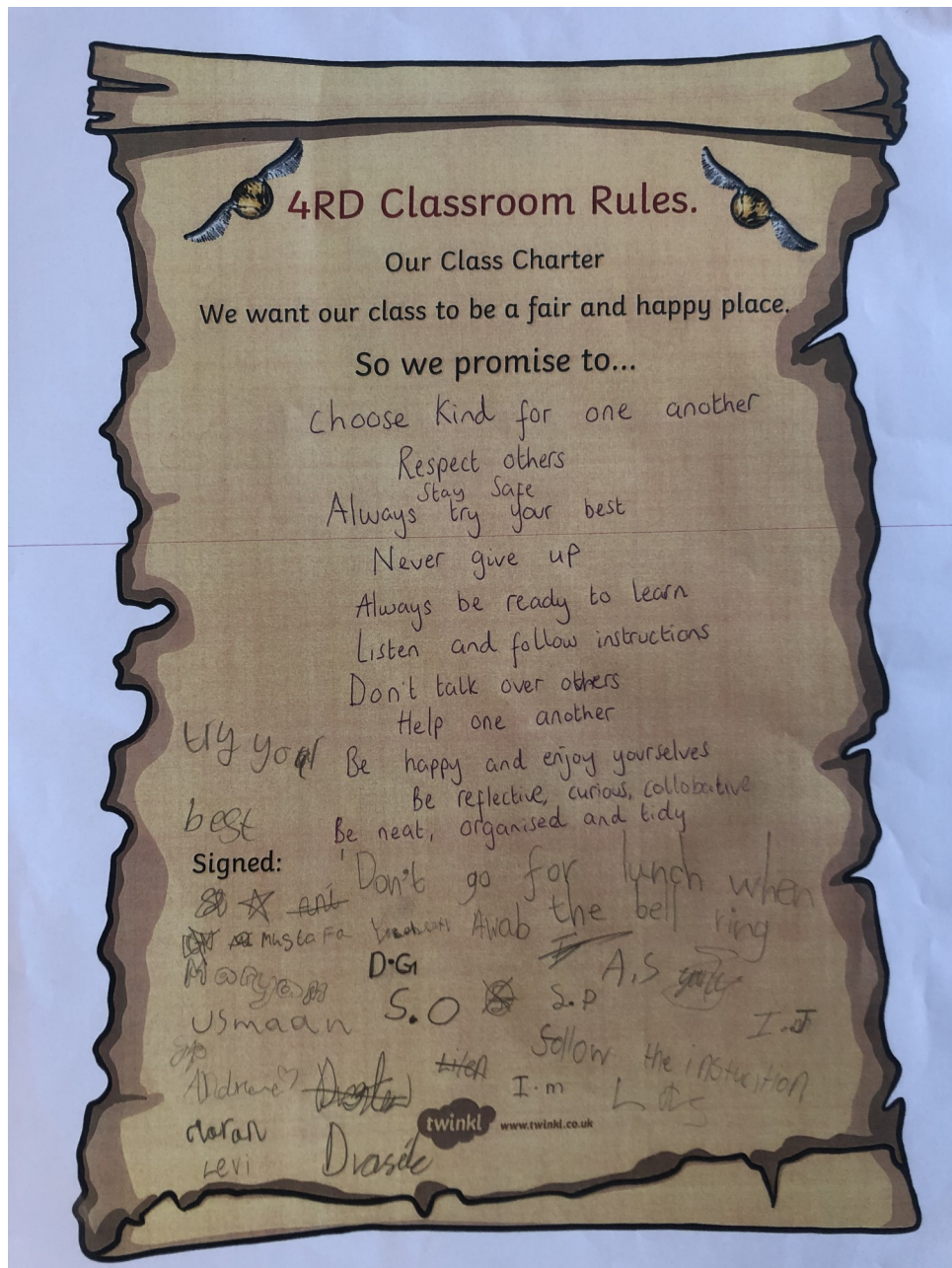


Knowing your times tables
